Due to the proprietary nature of data and the reporting of preliminary, unpublished research findings, the dissemination, reproduction and sharing of someone else's slides, poster(s), audio, video or data before, during or after AAIC 2022 is strictly prohibited.

Audio and video recording, and capturing of still images, are prohibited in the AAIC 2022 Exhibit Hall.

Please respect speaker instructions regarding the taking of photos, video or audio during their presentation.

Sharing your experience on social media is encouraged to add to the discussion and excitement of AAIC 2022, as long as it complies with AAIC 2022 embargo and confidentiality rules, and this policy. Sharing of images on social media that contain proprietary and/or unpublished research data is prohibited.

Violation of the above restrictions may result in appropriate penalty, including, but not limited to, removal from AAIC 2022, and denial of entry to future meetings and other conferences hosted by the Alzheimer's Association.
